Non-contentious work

- Applications to register trademarks and designs both in the United Kingdom and in the (EU)
 Community Registries and also, in the case of trademarks, in many other parts of the world
 through what is known as the Madrid Protocol.
- The licensing of intellectual property rights generally including copyright (including copyright in computer programs), design right, performance rights, trademarks, patents and technological know-how.
